- Manage departmental budget by ensuring bills are paid correctly and on time and by ensuring payment is collected and refunds are managed appropriately.
- Oversee Online Room Monitor's daily contact with student in online room.
- Create successful timelines for students to ensure positive results and spark creative learning.
- Consistently email and call parents and students to ensure seamless coursework between FLVS, student, and JSerra.
- Communicate regularly with principal, vice principals, IT, and FLVS principal to ensure student success
- Work with the Educational Technologist to develop training programs for online teachers. Ensure LMS is up to date. Ensure content is appropriately uploaded as needed.
- Receive weekly progress checks from outside vendor and follow up with Online Room Monitor to distribute updates to students and parents weekly.
- Coordinate all final face to face exams as well as math and English modular exams.
- Assess and evaluate online courses and instructors at FLVS.
- Schedule, pay, and train JSerra Online Teachers
- Meet regularly with incoming parents and students to explain facets of online program and benefits to the family.
- Oversee the UC/NCAA approvals of online classes.
