This position serves as the part-time, on-site counselor on-site for 2018-2019 school year.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

- Individual who will provide psychosocial assessments, treatment planning, individual and family therapy and case management.
- Provide short-term counseling for students referred by parents, teachers, administration and/or self-referral (junior high). Focus of counseling services for referral needs of anxiety, depression, adjustment issues, grief/loss and issues that affect academic progress and growth.
- Collaborate with faculty, staff, learning support and administration when a release of information is obtained to support psychosocial needs of student(s).
- Meet with families to discuss interventions and support needed from the family to partner for student progress and growth.
- Observe student behavior in classroom setting and on playground during recess and/or lunch breaks.
- Maintain thorough documentation of intake referral, treatment plan, progress and referral(s).
- May be invited to attend student support meetings for planning purposes.
- Serve on the school's student support team for ILP development.
- Other duties as assigned by administration.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Prefer a practicing Roman Catholic with a strong commitment to and working knowledge of the Catholic faith.
- Experience working in an office setting, maintaining professionalism and confidentiality.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE
