- A valid teaching credential, along with a minimum of two years teaching experience, is preferable
- Be a creative, thoughtful, and reflective educator
- Have comprehensive knowledge of and experience teaching math and social studies with an interdisciplinary approach
- Have excellent oral and written skills
- Act as a role model of professionalism in a Catholic environment
- Willing and able to take on additional duties as needed for the benefit of the students, the school, and/or the parish

Responsibilities Include:

- Teach social studies and math to students in a classroom utilizing a variety of curriculum resources
- Develop engaging lesson plans and instructional materials and provide individualized, small group and whole group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student
- Use a variety of instructional strategies, such as inquiry based methods, group discussion, experiential learning and project-based learning to meet the needs of each student

- Establish and maintain standards of student behavior needed to achieve a positive atmosphere in the classroom utilizing a positive discipline approach to classroom management
- Evaluate students' academic and social growth, keep appropriate records, and prepare progress reports three times per year
- Communicate with parents through face-to-face meetings, regular email, conferences and other means to discuss students' progress
- Create an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays and bulletin boards
- Maintain an organized classroom environment that is conducive to successful learning
- Participate in scheduled on-site professional development programs, staff meetings, parent-teacher conferences, school-wide events, and off-site field trips
- Prepare and maintain a safe, organized, healthy, academically, and behaviorally effective classroom environment appropriate to ongoing and changing classroom activities and in accordance with all accrediting regulatory, and governing organizations
- Complete all necessary paperwork in a timely manner including weekly lesson plans, weekly and quarterly student progress reports and assessments, and annual goals
