ATHLETIC DIRECTOR POSITION:

- 10 month, full-time.

- Assumes responsibility for the organization and scheduling of all extracurricular athletic events (games, practice schedules, pre-season parent meetings, team pictures, awards night).

- Coordinates scorebook, scoreboard, and helpers for all home athletic games.
- Serves as school liaison for Parochial Athletic League to implement and enforce league policies, and fulfill league duties.
- Collaborates with the administration to implement and enforce appropriate rules and regulations governing the conduct of athletic activities in the Parent-Student Handbook.
- Supervises the maintenance of athletic equipment/uniforms and maintains athletic inventory.
- Works as a liaison between administration, parents, coaches and student athletes.
- Considers and organizes a Football Tournament hosted by the school to help with program finances.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Principal.
