❖ Art Teacher – 5th - 8th Grade (28 hours per week)

Summary:

Will prepare lessons and provide developmentally-appropriate instruction on art techniques. Will supervise lessons and encourage creativity and self-expression among students.

Responsibilities:

- Plan lessons on art and art history in accordance with students' learning objectives.
- Prepare the classroom by gathering and setting up equipment. Instruction may include distance learning.
- Encourage students' drawing, coloring, and painting techniques.
- Provide instruction on the use of media such as graphite and charcoal pencils, as well as oil, acrylic, and watercolor paint.
- Teach students about art history.
- Assign and grade projects and examinations. Record and report on students' progress.
- Ensure that the classroom is clean after each lesson.
- Monitor inventory and source art supplies, as needed.
- Perform any other duties as may be assigned by Administration.
- Adhere to the policies and procedures of the Diocesan Employee Handbook and the St. Junipero Serra Catholic School Staff General Policies Handbook.

Position reports directly to the Principal, Upper School (Grade 5 – 8).
