



Kindergarten Teacher

The St. Angela Merici Parish School Kindergarten teacher is responsible for Kindergarten curriculum development. The candidate must support and uphold the philosophy of Catholic education and the mission of the school, witness to Gospel values and be willing to model the teachings of the Catholic Church. A successful candidate will possess the ability to demonstrate initiative, leadership, collaboration, and independent thinking.

Definition

Responsible for the instructional program and management of their assigned class or program in second grade. Essential duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Duties

- Provide academic subject instruction in second grade, ensuring that curriculum and schedule are followed.
- Follow Diocesan and State standards for each subject
- Preparing the class to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion
- Plan for class activities, including preparing units and daily lesson plans, identifying materials to implement class activities, preparing class projects, giving student feedback on completed work to insure mastery of presented material, and grading of tests and assignments in a timely manner.
- Communicate with parents on a regular basis about schedule, assignments, events, and individual student needs. Meet with parents during scheduled conferences during the school year and as requested.
- Maintain grades and curriculum assessments online.
- Attend weekly faculty meetings and participate on committees as assigned.
- Support the school by attending school sponsored events and activities.
- Commit to ongoing professional development via workshop attendance, visiting other schools, and webinars.
- Learn new skills and integrate technology as changing pedagogy dictates
