- Current CPR/First Aid

Under the direction of the Principal and the Day Care Coordinator, responsibilities of Extended Day Care staff include but are not limited to the following:

- Supervising daily activities with the students
- Assisting students with homework
- Adapting activities to meet the needs of students
- Sharing in housekeeping responsibilities of the EDC facility
- Attending required staff meetings
- Being punctual and reliable in reporting to work as scheduled
- Treating all children, apartments, and staff with dignity and respect
