Job Title: Substitute Teacher - TK-8th Grade (Catholic School)

Position Summary: A substitute teacher at a Catholic school provides instructional support and supervision in the absence of the regular classroom teacher. The substitute will create a positive and engaging learning environment, maintaining the academic and behavioral standards of the classroom while upholding the values and principles of the Catholic faith.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Instructional Delivery:

- Follow lesson plans provided by the regular classroom teacher, ensuring that all lessons are taught according to the prescribed curriculum.
- Adapt instructional materials and methods as needed to meet the individual learning needs of students.
- Provide clear explanations and reinforce key concepts in subjects such as Religion, Math, Science, Language Arts, and Social Studies for grades TK-8.

2. Classroom Management:

- Maintain a safe, respectful, and disciplined classroom environment.
- Implement classroom rules and procedures as outlined in the school's code of conduct.
- Address student behavior appropriately and in alignment with school policies, fostering a positive learning atmosphere.

3. Student Engagement:

- Must be flexible and adaptable to different teaching environments and grade levels.

Physical Demands:

- Ability to sit, stand, and walk for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to lift and move classroom materials (typically less than 20 lbs.).
- Ability to manage a classroom, including supervising students both inside and outside of the classroom.

Working Conditions:

- This position may require substitute work on short notice and can involve working in various classrooms and grade levels (TK-8).
- The position may involve working in a school setting during regular school hours, including mornings, afternoons, and occasional extended hours for meetings or events.
